




2. Do you find the health services to be easily accessible?








2. Are extracurricular activities well-promoted and easy to join?


3. Are student leadership opportunities, like student government, readily available? 3339 responses


1. Are there sufficient resources available to help manage stress?




2. Have you used any mental health services, and if so, were they effective?




Q 2The teachers are supported with adequate learning resources. ²⁸ responses




Q 3 Student centered learning resources are available in the college library ${\tt 28 \; responses}$




Q.4 The CBCS is better than 1+1+1 system ²⁸ responses




Q.5 NEP 2020 emphasizes a shift from rote learning to fostering a more comprehensive understanding in students




Q.6 The present syllabus is capable of enriching the subject specific knowledge of the students ^{28 responses}




Q.7 The present syllabus is job-oriented ^{28 responses}




Q.8 The evaluation system followed by the University is effective. ^{28 responses}




Q.9 The class rooms and furniture available are adequate ²⁸ responses




Q.10 The infrastructure available in the department is optimally used. 28 responses






Count of How Satisfied were you with the quality of education provided by college?




Count of How much are you aware of the present syllabus?
